

THE MILLENNIAL REIGN OF JESUS CHRIST

Revelation 20:1–15

From the beginning, God’s desire was to reign over his creation through a mediator. To that end, the King of the universe placed representative images of himself *in* his creation to *fill* his creation and *rule* his creation (Gen 1:26–28). But, *also* from the beginning, Satan’s desire was to usurp God and set himself up as sovereign. He deceived God’s first kingdom mediators, prompting them to *rebel* against the King rather than *represent* the King (Gen 3:1). In spite of the catastrophic effects of this fall, however, the original plan was never abandoned and God promised to one day establish a pristine, curse-free, never-ending global kingdom (e.g., 2 Sam 7:12–13; Ps 2:1–8) *within* which he would dwell with his creatures and *over* which he would eternally rule through a perfect Mediator (e.g., Isa 9:6–7). Revelation 20 predicts *that* time, a future moment when King Jesus will stomp sin, restore what was lost, and sit on his throne.
